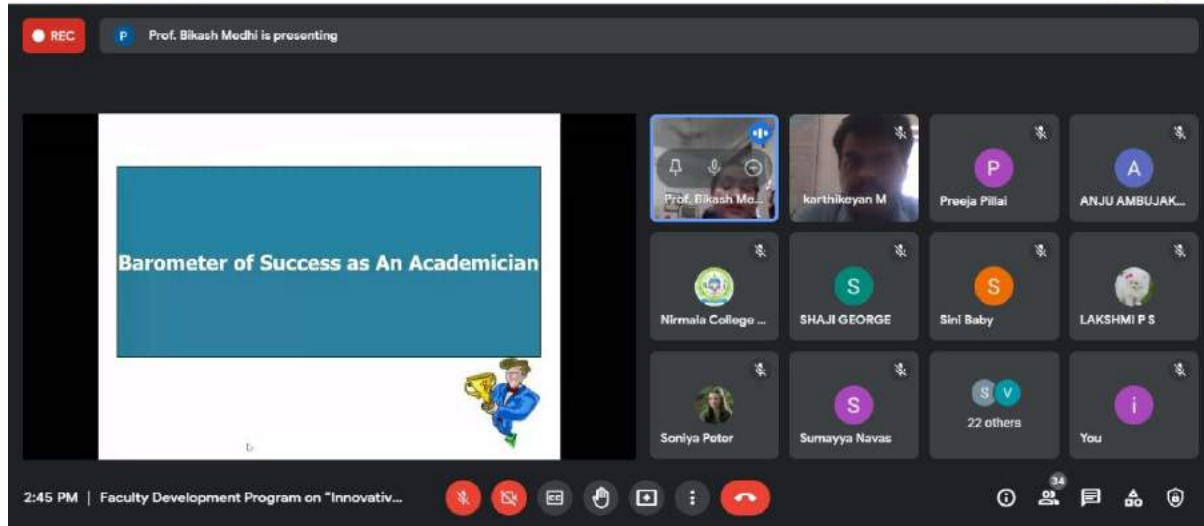
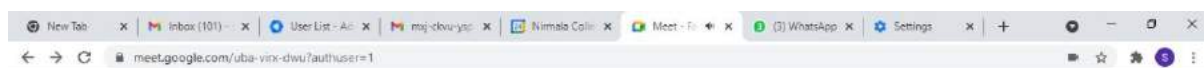
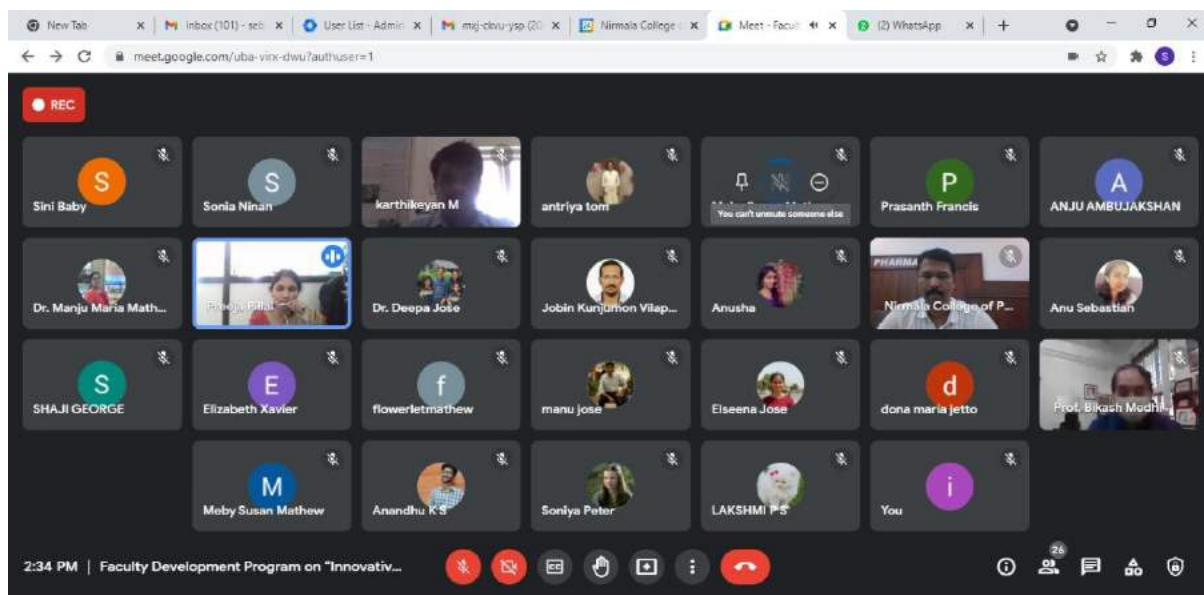

- To assist new faculty in developing productive research with Patent outcome.

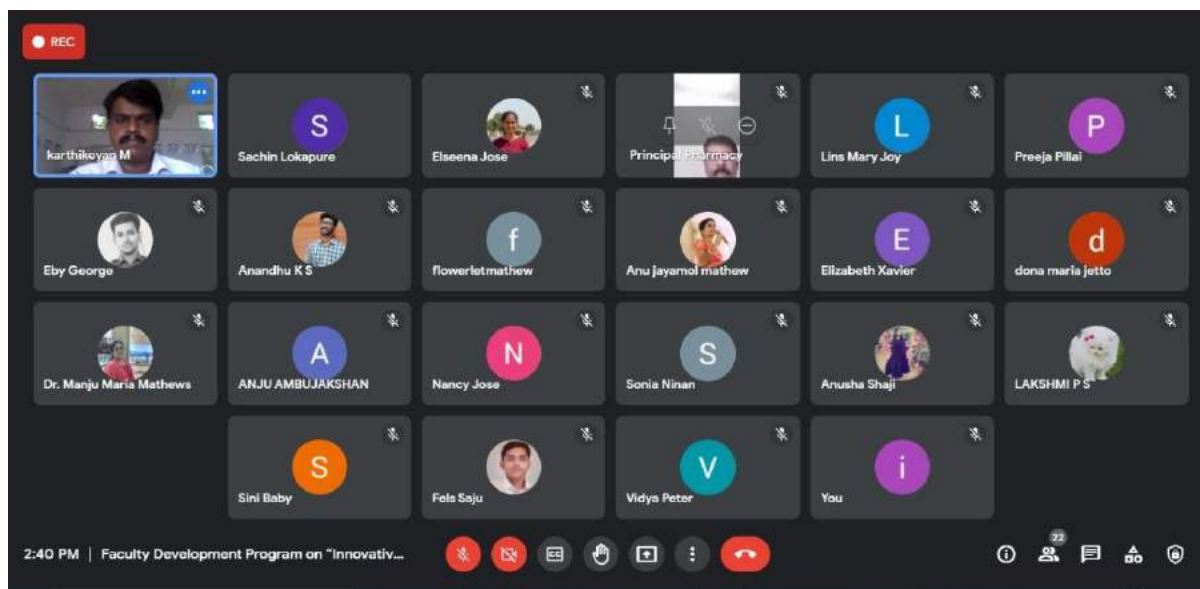
Summary of the session

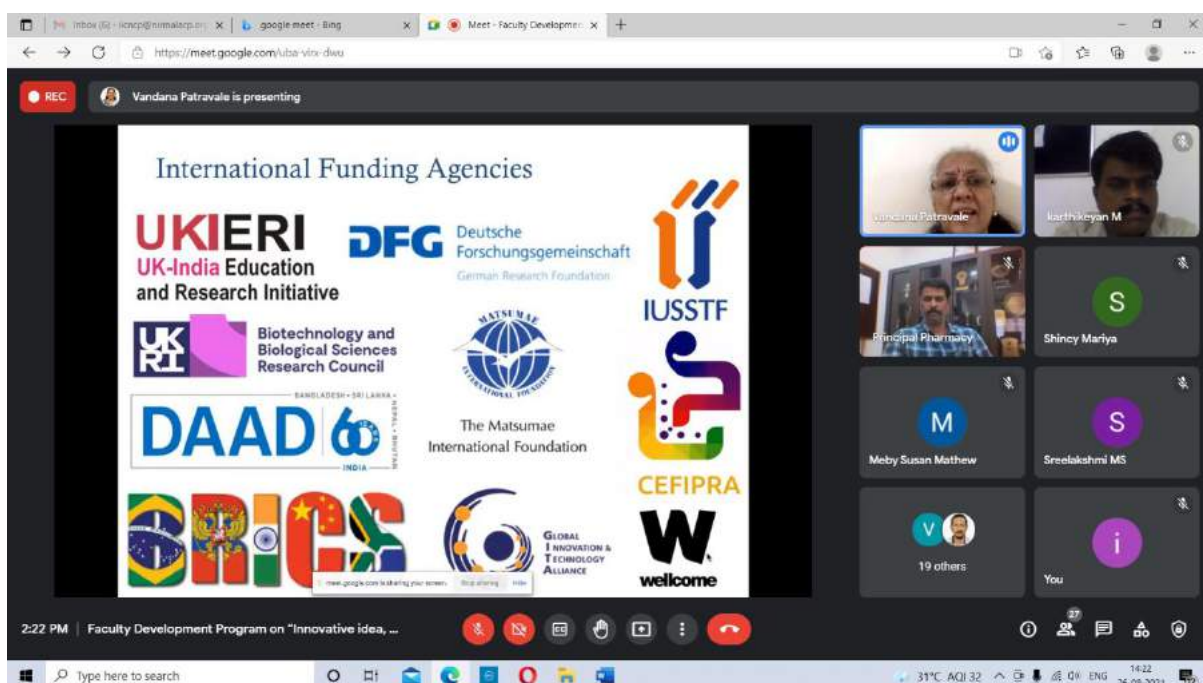
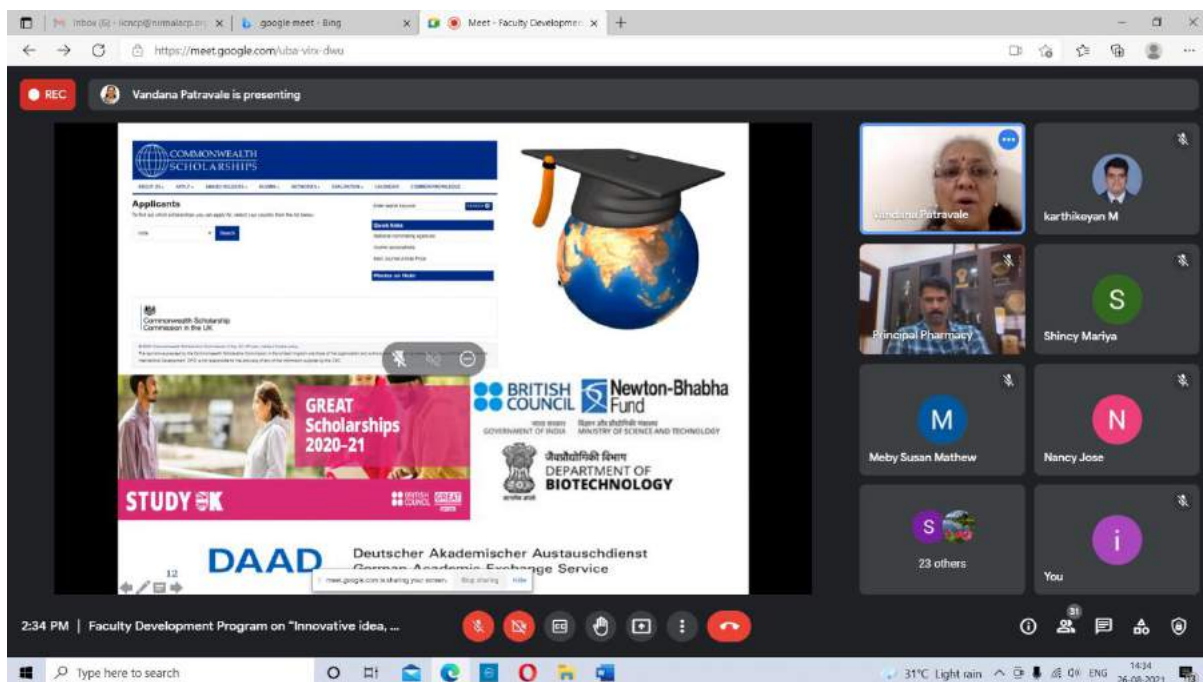
Dr Bikash Medhi delivering talk on “How to apply for national and International funding agencies and critical evaluation of projects for successful funding”

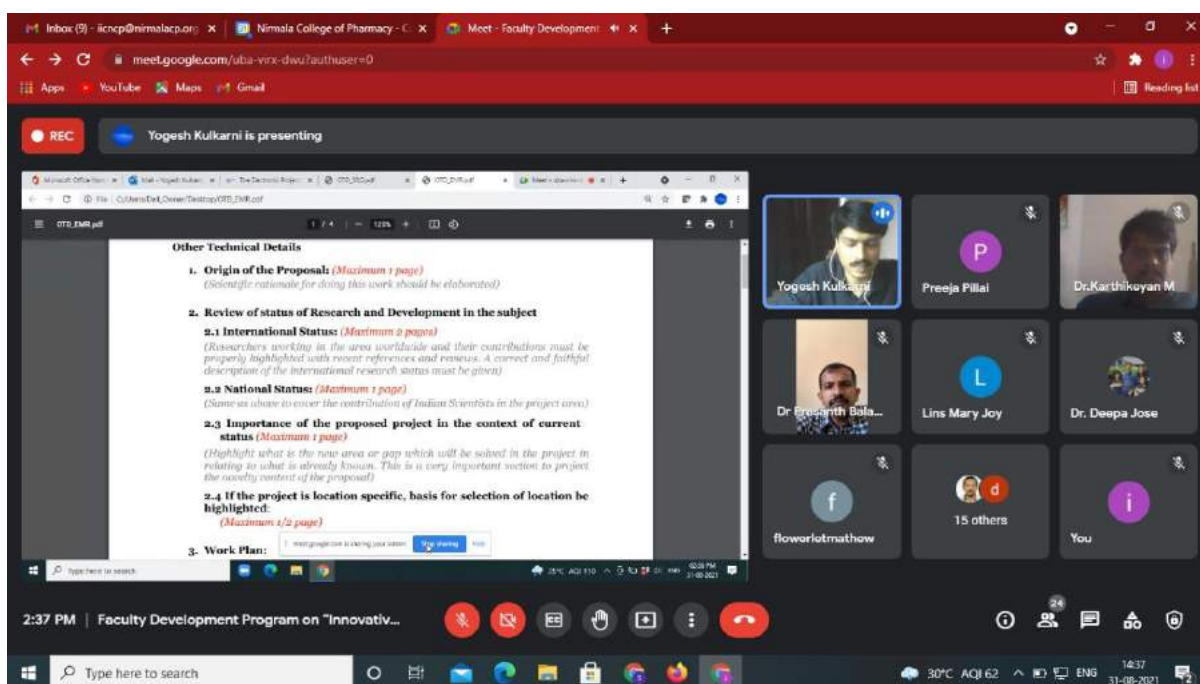
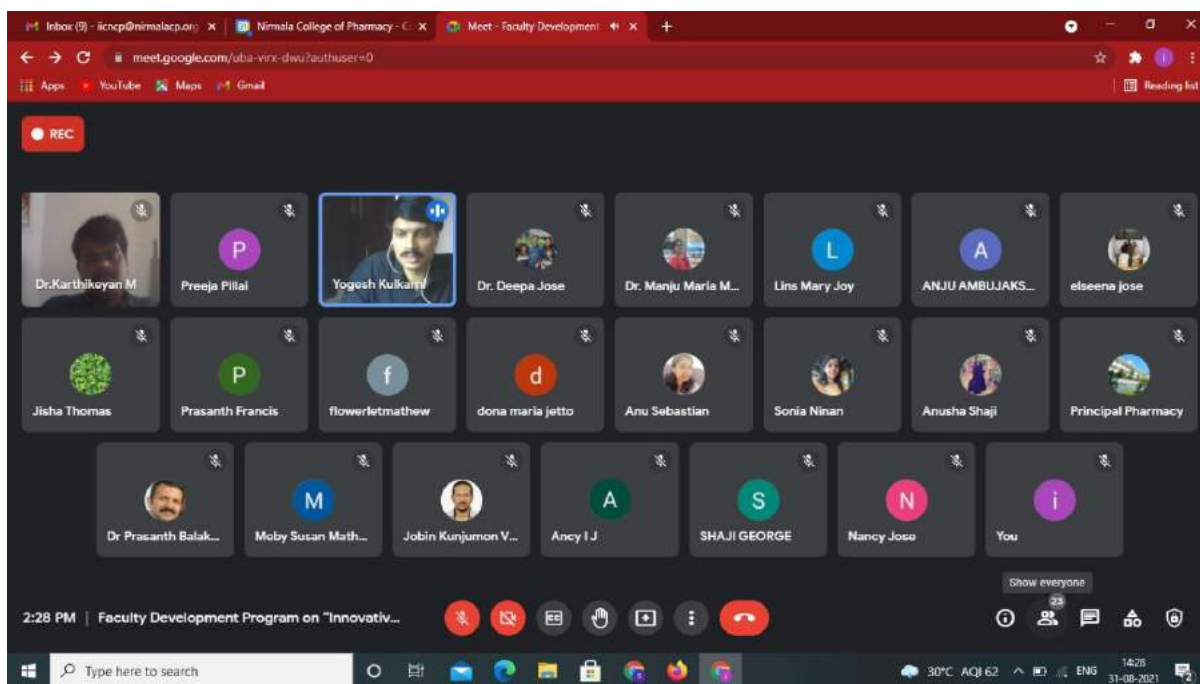
